Mack Kenneth Taylor, Sr, age 74, of Stockbridge, went to be with his Heavenly Father, Saturday, May 23, 2020. He was born May 21, 1946 in Stockbridge, GA to the late Cecil and Eva Taylor. Kenneth was also preceded in death by his son, Mack Kenneth Taylor, Jr.; brother, Jerry Taylor; brothers-in-law, Bobby Floyd, Hugh Flowers and Sonny Hardy. Kenneth's greatest love was for his Savior, Jesus Christ. Second he loved the gift of his wife and family. He especially enjoyed hunting with his boys, whether it was deer, dove, rabbits or raccoons. He has been an Assembly of God minister for over 35 years and pastored in the Georgia District. He was also an Assoc. Pastor for several churches. He was most recently serving in ministry with Pastor Ken Smith at Community Church of Praise. Kenneth was a licensed electrical contractor for forty years and owned and operated Kenneth Taylor Electric.
