



Nancy Annette Silvers

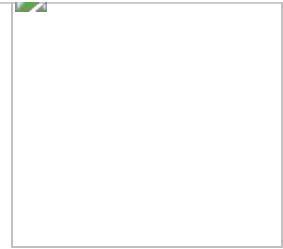
June 19, 1948 - August 20, 2020

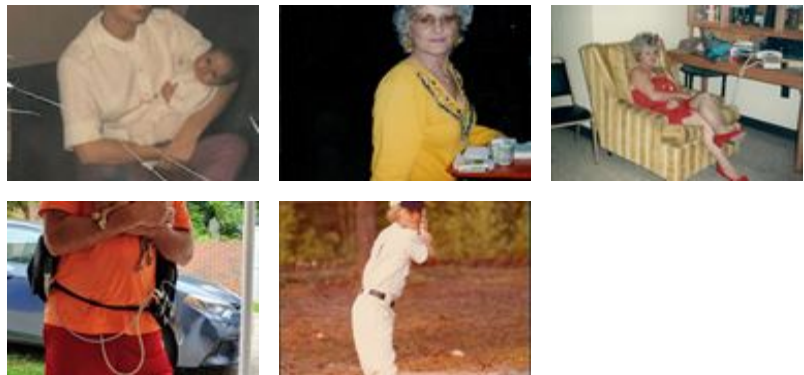
